What is combustible construction waste?

Combustible construction waste typically contains large amounts of wood, planks, and pallets.

The combustible construction waste first undergoes a process where recyclable fractions are sorted out and sent for recycling. The remaining waste is shredded and sent to an environmentally approved incineration facility.
