

Sorting Guide for Mixed Plastics and Cartons





What is hard plastic, soft plastic, and food & drink cartons?

Mixed plastics and food & drink cartons include, among other things, cardboard cartons from drinks and food, and both hard and soft plastic packaging from, for example, food products. The common requirement for all of them is that they must be emptied of their contents.

Mixed plastics and food & drink cartons are received at HCS' facility, where they are processed, baled, and then distributed for recycling.
