

## **Sorting Guide for Residual Waste**



## What is residual waste?

Residual waste is combustible waste smaller than  $50 \times 50 \times 100$  cm. It may contain small amounts of textiles, paper, plastic, or wood that are unsuitable for recycling.

Collected residual waste is transported for incineration at an environmentally approved facility.
