What is waste to be sorted?

Waste to be sorted refers to recyclable types of waste such as wood, metal, cardboard, paper, and plastic.

Waste to be sorted is received at HCS' facility, where it is mechanically sorted into several fractions, which are either sent for recycling or for incineration at an environmentally approved treatment plant.
