



Sorting Guide for Textiles



What is textile waste?

Textile waste is worn-out clothing and textiles, such as clothes and fabrics that are torn, worn, stained, or damaged and can no longer be used. Textile waste must be dry.

The textile waste passes through one of HCS's facilities for inspection and possible sorting before being sent for recycling.

- Blouses, pants, shirts, jeans, and sweaters
- Dresses and skirts
- Underwear
- Socks and stockings
- Sportswear and swimwear
- Clean cloth diapers
- Hats, gloves, and scarves
- Towels, dishcloths, and tea towels
- Bed linens and curtains

Note! The clothing/textile must be dry, free of food residues, dirt, and unwanted substances that may cause issues in recycling (e.g. chemicals, paint, and waterproofing agents).
