

Sorting Guide for Wood (A1 and A2)



What is wood waste?

Wood waste is typically clean or mechanically processed, discarded wood, such as wood from packaging, kitchens, pallets, clean demolition wood, particleboard, and plywood panels.

The mixed wood passes through one of HCS's facilities for inspection and possible sorting before being sent for recycling.

Note! The wood must have a maximum moisture content of 30%, be free of mold, mildew, and rot. Small foreign objects such as nails, screws, aluminum, fittings, and non-magnetic metals are accepted. *The blocks on the pallet must not consist of particleboard or similar materials.
